IF YOU WANT TO TAKE 12 CREDIT HOURS OR MORE:

1. Complete an application for admission.

Applications may be filled out online www.hawkeyecollege.edu or use the back of this Admissions Application. There is no application fee. You must indicate what major or program you wish to pursue. For more information, call the Admissions Office: 319-296-4000 or 800-670-4769, ext. 4000.

2. Send transcripts.

Official high school transcripts and/or GED scores must be sent to the Admissions office. Several technical programs require specific high school courses for admittance and any previous official college transcripts.

3. Send ACT scores or register for the COMPASS Assessment.

If you have taken the ACT's, your score will appear on your high school transcripts. Hawkeye evaluates the English, reading, and math sub scores. If you have not taken the ACT's, students must make an appointment to take the COMPASS Assessment. Students with prior college credit in a college-level math, reading or English course (with a passing grade or better) are usually not required to take the assessment. Some program requirements vary. Please call the Student Services Office at 319-296-4014 or 800-670-4769, ext. 1238 to schedule a COMPASS appointment.

IF YOU WANT TO TAKE A CLASS OR TWO (LESS THAN 12 CREDIT HOURS):

You do not need to complete an application. Call our registration office at 319-296-2460 or 800-670-4743. Tell us your name, social security number, and the course number you are interested in and we'll register you and give you the information you need to start the class. If you are taking your FIRST MATH or WRITING course, you are REQUIRED to provide acceptable ACT scores, recent college course work with passing grades in math or writing, or take the COMPASS assessment.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial assistance is available for all students regardless of their income or asset situation. All students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form at www.fafsa.ed.gov for all types of financial assistance.

There are four types of financial assistance available:

- 1. Grants:** Free money awarded based upon the results of your FAFSA.
- 2. Scholarships:** Free money awarded based upon completion of the Hawkeye Foundation Scholarship Application at www.hawkeyecollege.edu/foundation/application.aspx.
- 3. Work-Study:** On-campus employment funded by financial aid.
- 4. Loans:** Money students borrow while attending college, must be repaid after graduation.
