

Sample Two Year Schedule

First Semester:

Composition I	3 hrs.
Math Requirement	3 hrs.
Social Science Elective (Category A)	3 hrs.
Oral Communications	3 hrs.
General Electives	4 hrs.
Total	16 hrs.

Second Semester:

Composition II	3 hrs.
Natural Science Requirement	3 hrs.
Western Civilization I or II or III	3 hrs.
Social Science Elective (Category B)	3 hrs.
Literature and Fine Arts OR Philosophy and Religion Requirement	3 hrs.
Total	15 hrs.

Third Semester:

Natural Science Requirement (with lab)	4 hrs.
Social Diversity Requirement	3 hrs.
General Electives	9 hrs.
Total	16 hrs.

Fourth Semester:

Non-Western Cultures	3 hrs.
Social Science Elective (A, B, or C)	3 hrs.
General Electives	3 hrs.
Total	15 hrs.
