Students seeking a major in **Social Work, Psychology, Art/Art History, Athletic Training, Exercise Science, or Leisure Studies** must be admitted to the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (CLAS). These are just a sampling of CLAS majors. Check with an advisor concerning other majors at UofI. <http://www.uiowa.edu/homepage/academics/index.html>

Students who have completed the AA degree from HCC will have completed all general education requirements for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (CLAS) with the exception of the Foreign Language requirement.

Students must meet fourth level proficiency in a single foreign language. This can be met through **four years of high school, four semesters of college, or any appropriate combination of the two.** Students transferring without the AA degree typically will need to have second level proficiency completed just to be admitted.
